YMC Board Application 2015-2016 DUE: Friday, May 22, 2015

Youth Making Change (YMC) is a teen-led grant-making program providing young people with the opportunity to engage directly in organized philanthropy (giving grants). Each YMC Board (one meets in Santa Maria and one meets in Santa Barbara) gives out \$15,000 in grants to projects led by youth that impact young people in Santa Barbara County. YMC board members are teens ages 13 to19. They create and conduct an entire grant cycle from start to finish and then share what they have learned as grant-makers and philanthropists with their communities. Each YMC board is led by two Youth Facilitators who are previous YMC board members. Since 2008, YMC has awarded \$157,500 to 90 youth-led groups throughout Santa Barbara County.

What YMC Members Do

Board membership runs from July 2015 to May 2016. YMC members meet twice a month for the school year to plan and carry out a grant cycle.

First, members learn about philanthropy and grant-making. They also learn about current issues facing young people in Santa Barbara County and share their own perspectives and opinions. They reach out to youth in the community to encourage them to plan a project and apply for money to carry it out. Board members receive grant applications from youth-led groups and review proposed project ideas. They conduct interviews of applicants and make decisions as a group about which projects to support.

Each board has \$15,000 to give to youth-led groups trying to improve the lives of young people in the community. After making their grants, YMC Board members plan a celebration and conduct follow-up site visits. Board members develop important leadership skills and experience including meeting planning and facilitation, outreach and public speaking, program planning, proposal evaluation and group decision-making.

YMC MEMBER REQUIREMENTS

- $_{\odot}$ Be between the ages of 13 and 19 as of 8/1/15
- $_{\odot}$ Live or go to school in Santa Barbara County
- $_{\odot}$ Attend an all day training on Sat. August 1, 2015
- Attend meetings twice a month, 6:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m. from August 2015 to May 2016*
 - Mtgs in Santa Maria: 1st & 3rd Wednesdays.
 - Mtgs in Santa Barbara: 1st & 3rd Thursdays.
- Read and discuss grant applications & share your opinions
- \circ Work with a diverse group of teens, be a leader and have FUN!

*Other meetings include one additional Saturday meeting. There is also some independent work between meetings.

Who gets selected?

The goal is to establish a 15 member board that reflects the diversity of young people in the county. Youth are selected from different neighborhoods, schools, grades, academic levels, and life experiences. Youth are encouraged to apply regardless of race, gender, religion, economic status, sexual orientation, academic status, physical/mental ability, ethnicity, language spoken, or immigration status.

\$300 STIPEND

Participating in YMC is voluntary, but you do get a \$300 stipend for your participation in recognition of your time commitment. The stipend is based on participation throughout the board term.

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Youth Making Change (Jovenes Haciendo Cambio) o YMC, es un programa dirigido por adolescentes que otorga becas. Empezó en el 2008 para darle la oportunidad a adolescentes que participen directamente en la filantropía organizada (dar becas). Cada Mesa de YMC (uno se reune en Santa María y otro se reune en Santa Bárbara), reparte \$15,000 dólares en becas para proyectos dirigidos por jóvenes que impactan a los jóvenes en el Condado de Santa Bárbara. Miembros de YMC son adolescentes de 13-19 años de edad. Crean y llevan a cabo un ciclo de otorgación becas y luego comparten lo que han aprendido como filántropos en sus comunidades. Cada Mesa de YMC es dirigida por dos jóvenes facilitadores que son miembros anteriores de YMC. Los facilitadores ayudan a que cumplan sus objetivos, así como dar una perspectiva jóvenes con experiencia en el proceso de dar becas. Desde el año 2008, YMC ha otorgado \$157,500 a 9 grupos dirigidos por jóvenes en todo el Condado de Santa Bárbara.

2. Make sure you can attend the MANDATORY County-Wide Training on Saturday, August 1, 2015

3. **Complete the following application in BLACK ink or type**. Electronic copies in WORD format are available on our website or by contacting our office. If you need more space to answer the questions, add one additional page. If you are using a separate sheet of paper, <u>label it with your name</u>. If you fill out the application on a computer, use a 12pt font and DO NOT exceed the three page limit for the essay questions.

4. Sign the YMC Board Commitment Statement on the last page.

5. **Get your parent/guardian to sign** the Commitment Statement on the last page. A parent/guardian signature is **required by law** if you are less than 18 years old. If you are 18 or older, it is not necessary, but if you live with them but it would be nice to have so that we know that they support you in participating.
